

The Superior Greenway Partners

The Superior Greenway was envisioned by SMLC Founder, Jack R. Smiley, to be a greenbelt between Detroit and Ann Arbor, one that would preserve wildlife habitat and facilitate public access to nature. That vision was embraced by each of the following partners:

Southeast Michigan Land Conservancy

conserves natural land and open space – including forests, wetlands, meadows,

The Open Space and Parkland Preservation Program (commonly referred to as the Greenbelt

Kosch-Headwaters Preserve

3268 N. Prospect Rd., Superior Twp., MI 48198 (park onsite)

The preserve shares a beech-maple woods and hiking trail with the adjacent Springhill Nature Preserve and boasts an abundance of spring



wildflowers such as bloodroot, trillium, geranium, and spring beauty. It lies in the headwaters of the Rouge River and hosts wetlands, seasonal

streams and a spring.

Cherry Hill Nature Preserve

6221 Cherry Hill Rd., Superior Twp., MI 48198 (park along road)

This quiet preserve features a heavily wooded glacial moraine, wetlands and meadow. The wildlife population here is as diverse as the terrain, with a



resident owl population and many other bird species.

Secrest and Weatherbee Woods Nature Preserves, and Schroeter Park

8730-8776 Warren Road, Superior Township, MI 48170 (park onsite at Schroeter Park or the Secrest Nature Preserve – anticipated in 2022)



This northern Greenway complex includes a 2-mile public trail that meanders through stunning oakhickory woods and rolling topography along the Rouge River tributary. The 80-acre Secrest Nature Preserve is the newest addition to the 278-acre contiguous protected area.

Facts at a Glance

- Southeast Michigan Land Conservancy (SMLC) has been protecting land in the 7-county southeast Michigan region since 1988.
- SMLC's Superior Township Chapter (STC) was established in 1991, and is helping preserve the rural character and natural habitats of Superior Township.
- The Superior Greenway Partners have protected more than 2,700 acres, with over 1,600 acres available for public access.
- The Superior Greenway Nature Trail begins at SMLC's Jack R. Smiley Nature Preserve and meanders through Washtenaw County's Meyer Preserve to the south where it connects with existing trails at SMLC's LeFurge Woods Nature Preserve. The Trail is approximately 1.75 miles in length and trail users can access it from Superior Township Hall and Vreeland Rd.
- SMLC is a certified IRS 501(c)3 nonprofit; charitable donations to SMLC are tax deductible.



Highlights of Key Nature Preserves

LeFurge Woods Nature Preserve

2384 N. Prospect Rd., Superior Twp., MI 48198 (parking onsite off Prospect Rd.)

This popular preserve protects 325 acres of farmland and natural habitat. The site represents a variety

of southern Michigan habitat types, including wetlands, grasslands, forests and swamps. Trails wind through these diverse habitats



including the beautiful "LeFurge Woods" allowing for some of the best wildlife viewing in the Detroit-Ann Arbor region.

Conservancy Farm

8383 Vreeland Rd., Superior Twp., MI 48198 (parking onsite)

Located in the heart of the Superior Greenway, this 99-acre site consists of peaceful woods, grasslands,



and farm fields. The historic farmstead includes SMLC's office, an early 1900's brick farmhouse, the original 1830's settlers' log cabin and the iconic post-and-beam "big

red barn". Popular activities include the Community Organic Garden program, birdwatching and photography.

Jack R. Smiley Nature Preserve

8080 Cherry Hill Rd., Superior Twp., MI 48198 (park at Superior Township Hall)

The preserve is named after SMLC's founder and marks the northern end of the Superior Greenway Nature Trail. The trailhead includes an ADA-accessible overlook area and native plant and insect gardens. Scenic views along the farmland Trail include two stream crossings and several wetland restoration areas before the Trail crosses onto the adjacent Meyer Preserve.
