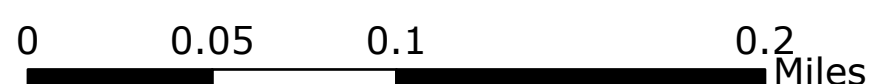
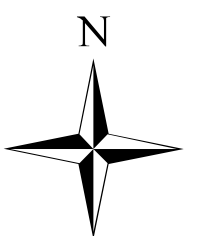


The Preserve Loop Trail

The trail system is approximately 1.25 miles in total length. Shortly after the trailhead, the trail traverses a prairie restoration area where over 15 acres of shrubs and trees were removed in 2015 to improve the globally rare lakeplain prairie remnant. SMLC manages this prairie using invasive species control methods including prescribed fire. The prairie represents what portions of southeast Michigan looked like before and during the 1800's. As the trail winds north, it transitions into a beautiful hardwood forest consisting of oaks and maples before looping around and returning along the same route back to the trailhead.
